DEFINITIONS

The following definitions apply to words or terms used in SYSTEMS INTEGRATION PROTOCOL 1.0 – SERVICE COORDINATION FOR JUVENILES CONCURRENTLY SERVED BY THE CHILD WELFARE AND JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEMS

History – Children's Administration, Division of Children and Family Services (DCFS): The child/youth has previously received but is not currently receiving Child Protective, Child Welfare or Family Reconciliation Services from DCFS.

History – Juvenile Court Services: The child/youth was previously under but is not currently under the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court pursuant to an information filed under Chapter 13.40 RCW.

Open Case – Children's Administration, DCFS: The child/youth is currently receiving Child Protective, Child Welfare or Family Reconciliation Services from DCFS. A petition filed under Chapter 13.32A or 13.34 RCW is not a pre-requisite to a case being considered open.

Open Case – Juvenile Court Services: The child/youth is currently under the jurisdiction of the court pursuant to an information filed under Chapter 13.40 RCW and has a JPC assigned to his/her case. An open case can be pre or post adjudication.
