SYSTEMS INTEGRATION EDUCATION SUBCOMMITTEE

MEETING: King County Juvenile Court 1:30pm

We reviewed our previous discussions and possible areas of focus.

This included the role of the ESD in placement of out-of-school youth in an education program, expansion of Youth Source/ One Stop and the current partnerships that exist in the community, including Juvenile Probation Community Programs, Detention ASD, Seattle School District/Interagency Programs, Public Health, Casey Family, etc.

We established the following as possible goals for our Subcommittee:

- *Identifying, creating and/or supporting successful secondary high school completion programs and GED programs

- *Targeting South Central Seattle and Southeast King County (S. Kent, Auburn, Black Diamond, Algona-Pacific, Federal Way) as potential new sites for additional Youth Source/ One Stop programs

- *Work with Puget Sound ESD to create a neutral funding stream for \$ to fund these highly successful alternative education options for youth: Goals would include “the \$ follows the kid”.

- *Partner with Work Force Development Council in the development and maintenance of these educational opportunities.

- *Include Out-of-Home Youth (foster care, Kinship Care, Homeless youth) in the plan

Probation Department will gather end of year data on probation youth and their school status to be reported in January.
